GENERAL INFORMATION

The South Suburban Park and Recreation Professional Association established an educational scholarship to assist students in furthering their educational endeavors. A \$ 500.00 scholarship is available to a full time student pursuing a degree in the field of park, recreation, conservation, therapeutic recreation, massage therapy, and/or leisure services. Applicants will be judged on academic achievement, related professional experiences, leadership and demonstration of professional involvement. Payment of the award will be made to the scholarship recipient at the April 10, 2025 Awards Presentation.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must:

- Be a student member of the South Suburban Park and Recreation Professional Association <u>at the time of application</u> for this scholarship. (applications at ssprpa.org).
- Be currently pursuing a degree in the field of park, recreation, conservation, therapeutic recreation, massage therapy, and/or leisure services.
- Show proof of enrollment in a college or university level parks and recreation program by providing transcripts. (Seniors must have proof of enrollment in graduate studies the following year).
- Carry a minimum of 2.5/4.0 or 3.0/5.0 grade point average for all courses of study.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Complete the application form.
- 2. Sign the application.
- 3. Have the department head or faculty member sign the application to verify student status and grade point average.
- 4. Include a resume outlining academic achievement, related professional experiences, leadership and demonstration of professional involvement.
- 5. Include a brief personal statement describing why they should receive the award.
- 6. Include one letter of recommendation from employer or professor in the field of parks and recreation.
- 7. Include proof of enrollment by providing transcripts.
- 8. Application must be postmarked by March 24, 2025
- 9. Mail or e-mail application, personal statement, resume and letter of recommendation to the chairperson listed below.
